BRITISH CASTING CERTIFICATE
Previously called BOA/RCN[SOTN]/AOT Casting Certificate*

The British Orthopaedic Association maintains a Register of holders of the British Casting Certificate and Employers can check their employee's status by emailing recert@boa.ac.uk

British Casting Certificate (BCC) holders are expected to follow the Code of Conduct from the BOA Casting Committee, to undertake Continuing Professional Development and recertify every 3 years. The cost of which is currently only £13.33 per year.

N.B. Please notify the British Orthopaedic Association immediately of any change of address or name, which occur in the interim. To do this please complete and return the membership update form enclosed with the profile [*green*] or by emailing recert@boa.ac.uk

BCC holders must keep an up to date profile and:

- Record the hours worked in practical casting since last renewal, which must be more than 150 hours over the three year period.
- Record details of your Professional development. The requirements are 5 days or 35 hours of relevant study within 3 years,

This could be:

- ◆ attendance at study days, conferences and workshops with evidence of reflection
- ◆ evidence of private study or learning activity
- ◆ undertaking research
- ◆ publication of articles
- ◆ giving presentations at conferences or workshops
- ◆ recorded 'reflective practice'.

What happens if you are not currently applying casts?

Return the completed Registration Form and your name will be placed in the lapsed section. If you wish to return to the live register, you will need to apply to the Committee, satisfy the Committee's recommendations on how to return to practice and will have to pay an additional fee.
