reviewed by the Selection Design Group. The group, which was established in 2013, is now

seeking further new members from established consultants with an appropriate interest and

have faced this year as a result of the coronavirus pandemic and as a group we must ensure

that the process in 2021 reassures the wider Trauma & Orthopaedics community that we
